

# SUSTAINABLE PURCHASING POLICY

## Objectives

- To reduce the hotel's environmental impact by favouring sustainable products and services.
- Support socially responsible practices by sourcing from suppliers who respect workers' rights and social standards.
- Contribute to local economic development by favouring local suppliers.

## Scope of application

This policy applies to all hotel purchases, including food products, operating supplies, equipment and services.

## Sustainable purchasing criteria

Products and services will be selected according to the following criteria:

### Environment :

- Eco-certified products
- Products made from sustainable materials
- Products with a low environmental impact (carbon footprint, water consumption, etc.)
- Local and/or seasonal products
- Second-hand or reconditioned products
- Select bulk products
- Reduce plastic packaging and favour cardboard and recyclable packaging

### Social :

- Respect for workers' rights and social standards
- Suppliers committed to ethical practices
- Fair trade products

**Local:**

- Priority given to local suppliers
- Locally manufactured products

**Examples of sustainable purchasing**

- Food products: organic, local and/or seasonal products, quality labels, etc.
- Operating supplies: eco-certified, refillable, compostable products
- Equipment: energy-efficient, made from sustainable materials
- Services: local service providers committed to a sustainable approach

**Implementation**

The sustainable procurement policy will be implemented through the following actions:

- Staff training: raising staff awareness of sustainable development issues and sustainable purchasing criteria
- Drawing up purchasing procedures: integrating sustainable purchasing criteria into purchasing procedures
- Monitoring and reporting: performance monitoring and regular reporting

**Monitoring and reporting**

The sustainable purchasing policy will be monitored and reported using the following indicators:

- Share of sustainable purchases
- Reduction in the hotel's carbon footprint
- Number of local suppliers
